



- 1.1 The "Binding Corporate Rules (UK): Controller Policy" and "Binding Corporate Rules (UK): Processor Policy" (together the " " or, respectively, the " " and the " ") provide a framework for the transfer of Personal Information between RGA group members (" "). The purpose of the Privacy Training Program (UK) (Processor) document is to provide a summary as to how RGA trains its Workforce Members on the requirements of the Processor Policy
- 1.2 RGA trains its Workforce Members whose roles will bring them into contact with Personal Information, on the basic principles of data protection, confidentiality and information security awareness. It also provides specific training on particular legal obligations, such as the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 ('HIPAA') in the US, and requirements and best practices, such as those specified by the International Organization for Standards (ISO) 27001, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), and the UK GDPR.
- 1.3 Workforce Members who have permanent or regular access to Personal Information and are involved in the Processing of Personal Information or in the development of tools to Process Personal Information are required to complete the Privacy Training Program (UK) (Processor) document.
